**Sunday, October 27, 12:00-4:00 PM. NASHUA CROP WALK FOR HUNGER!!** This will be a Youth Group sponsored service/missions project but all are welcome to participate. We walk to help raise awareness of hunger globally, nationally and locally. Our church family is encouraged to support this by donating, walking, praying or simply by learning more about hunger. This will be the 4th year our church has participated in the Nashua CROP walk; We hope to once again exceed our previous year's financial support through fundraising; **As of 10/20, the Dunstable church has raised \$304.00 of our \$750.00 goal this year. Please consider donating to the Crop Walk for Hunger. The last contributions can be accepted on Sunday morning during fellowship, 10/27. There will be a collection basket on the fellowship table until the walkers leave at 12:05 pm.**

Since 1985, the Nashua Area CROP Walk has raised a total of \$1,002,417.37! Twenty-five percent of the funds are donated to support these local agencies: Nashua Soup Kitchen and Shelter, Corpus Christi Food Pantry, the Salvation Army, and St. John Neumann Food Pantry. The rest of the funds are split between national and international hunger needs.
