NASHUA CROP WALK FOR HUNGER says THANK YOU!! You donated \$719 to our Youth Group to present to the Nashua Crop Walk for Hunger on that rainy Sunday, October 27th. The walk helps to raise awareness of hunger globally, nationally and locally. This was the 4th year our church has participated in the Nashua CROP walk, each year exceeding our previous year's financial support through fundraising. 10 people from the church walked, and about 300 participated. Again, THANK YOU for your support.

Our food and personal care items drive continues to fill the boxes in support of PACH. Pepperell Aid for Community and Home is the food pantry for Pepperell and Dunstable residents, and serves hundred of families and individuals each year. You will find a basket in the Narthex (front entry) and totes in Fellowship Hall. Nearly 3% of our local residents sometimes run out of food and cannot afford to buy more. PACH provides canned & boxed foods, frozen meats, vegetables, fruits, bread & dairy when available. Also personal items likes toothpaste, soap, diapers, wipes, shampoo, toilet paper, tissues, paper towels. PACH can help with Food Assistance programs, and Resources for Referrals to WIC. SNAP, other services and Fuel Assistance programs.

Please read the information located near the boxes in Fellowship Hall. Volunteers will pick up donations weekly or as needed. This drive will continue until Thanksgiving.


